What an exciting weekend we had! On Saturday we had a Ministry Meeting that was positive and energetic, despite the fact that it was 8am in the morning. Everyone there was full of excitement and enthusiasm for the potential that exists at our church. Then the joy that began there was carried over into Sunday as Keke preached a powerful sermon about saying "Yes" to God. Even the lesson that was prepared on the Parable of the Tenants really encouraged us all to recognize the gifts that God has given us and to be careful not to waste them, but to use them for his glory. This can be applied both in the church and throughout His kingdom. In the teen class, I asked them all to share something they have said "yes" to and how God has blessed them because of it.
